A handyperson service to reduce hazards and prevent falls in the home

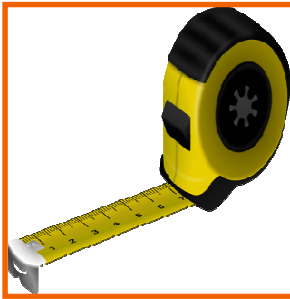
If you are, or know someone who is:

- aged 65 and over; or
- vulnerable or has a disability; or
- being discharged or has recently been discharged from hospital; or
- at high risk of falling due to a medical condition

Then you, or they, may qualify for this FREE service.

Our service covers a wide range of minor repairs in and around the home, for example:

- fitting grab rails
- making loose carpets and trailing wires safe
- changing light fittings or bulbs
- making your front path safer
- any other small jobs to make your home free from trip hazards
